CANDIDACY REQUIREMENTS

- **CANDIDATES MUST SUBMIT A COMPLETE APPLICATION BY THE DEADLINE MARCH 11 TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:**
 - **PCP SGA Candidate Application Form; must be signed by student and parent/guardian**
 - **Typed essay response to the following prompt (250 words or less): *Describe what makes you a good candidate for the position to which you are applying. What differentiates you from the other candidates? If given the opportunity, what SGA event would you propose that would benefit the program, SGA, and the student body?***
 - **PCP Counselor Recommendation Form**

- **CANDIDATES MUST HAVE A 3.0 OR HIGHER AT TIME OF APPLICATION AND MAINTAIN A 3.0+ GPA WHILE SERVING IN OFFICE.**

- **CANDIDATES MUST GIVE A CANDIDACY SPEECH (60 SECONDS OR LESS). SPEECHES AND ELECTIONS WILL BE HELD ON APRIL 29 DURING GENERAL ASSEMBLY.**

April 25	APPLICANTS WILL BE NOTIFIED OF THEIR CANDIDACY STATUS.
APRIL 29	ALL CANDIDATES WILL GIVE A SPEECH 60 SECONDS OR LESS TO THE STUDENT BODY DURING GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
APRIL 29	ELECTIONS WILL TAKE PLACE DURING SATURDAY ACADEMY ASSEMBLY.
APRIL 29	WINNERS WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
May 6	THE NEWLY ELECTED OFFICERS WILL BE NOTIFIED OF THE FIRST SGA MEETING BY SGA ADVISOR AND/OR NEW SGA PRESIDENT.
